## SANDWICH SUNDAY IS BACK! November 15<sup>th</sup>





Sandwich Sunday will look a little different, as are most things these days. We are asking that families make the sandwiches at <u>home</u>. Although we miss everyone very much, we want everyone to stay safe as we continue our Ministry. And what a testament to our family of families giving to others!

Bring sandwiches to Auditorium on November 15th. We will have two different drop off times for your convenience. The first will be between the hours of 9am-11am. If you can't make it in the morning, the second drop off time will be 5pm-6pm. We will be collecting and boxing the sandwiches outside of the Auditorium entrance.

We ask that everyone please wear a mask and gloves while preparing sandwiches. Each sandwich should be placed in its own baggie. Peanut butter and Jelly are the easiest to make. Please keep in mind one loaf of bread makes 10 sandwiches. We will also accept cold cut sandwiches, we just ask that you label them.

If you need supplies, we will be leaving baggies and gloves with the Parish Office starting Monday, November 9<sup>th</sup>. Please try to make sandwiches as close to Sunday as possible, as they will be delivered to Light House Mission in Bellport on Monday morning. We will also be accepting supply donations for those that would like to contribute but can't make sandwiches, such as, peanut butter, jelly, or bread. We will be placing a quick instruction video on Facebook and Youtube. We miss you all and look forward to seeing you all soon.


