

Altar servers need to be in fourth grade or above, should be attending Sunday Mass and desire to get more involved in the life of the parish and the Church.



IRA Charitable Rollover = Great Opportunity Under New Tax Laws

Whether you itemize or not in 2018, this unique opportunity allows you to make a charitable contribution through a direct IRA transfer while reducing your adjusted gross income.

If you would like to make a gift now using your Ira and if:

- 1.You are at least 70 1/2 years old on the date you make your gift
- 2.Your IRA is a traditional (some Roth IRAs may qualify)
- 3. You don't exceed your personal maximum of \$100,000 per year in qualified charitable distributions

You will not have to report your distribution as income. It will be free of federal and New York State income tax, and it will count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD).

The best way for you to start is with your IRA custodian. Tell them you want to make a "qualified charitable distribution". In most cases you will only have to fill out a simple form.

VERY IMPORTANT!! Your gift must go directly from your IRA to our Parish. If you receive the money first then you'll be taxed on it like any other distribution. Bill has a \$125,000 in a traditional IRA and would like to contribute \$5,000 as his yearly gift to his Parish. Upon hearing of the Charitable IRA Rollover opportunity, he directs the custodian of his IRA to transfer this amount not later than December 31, 2018 directly to the Parish as the family's 2018 gift. He will not be subject to income tax on the \$5,000 donation.



Discussion Questions

1. Is the point of this reading to lay blame for the suffering servant's death, or to tell us that sin can be erased and the offenders can be raised to new life by the same power that raised Jesus to life?

2. Discuss Pope Francis statement regarding today's Second Reading from St. John's letter:

The Lord has redeemed all of us, all of us, with the Blood of Christ: all of us, not just Catholics. Everyone! 'Father, the atheists?' Even the atheists.

3. He appeared in their midst. But why did Jesus say, "Peace be with you" to his disciples? What was the emotional atmosphere in the group at that time? Are there times in your life when you

are distraught and you need some peace? Does it help you that Jesus has experienced trials like yours? Did God take our flesh because he needed to do so, or because it was us who needed him to?
