FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Leave a little room for the...

HOLY SPIRIT

Dear Parish Family:

We're making a bit of an Easter turn this week as both the readings and the feasts we celebrate will prepare for the celebration of Pentecost and indwelling of the Holy Spirit. I always feel, even in my own prayer, the Holy Spirit gets the short stick in terms of recognition and awareness. We're more comfortable with the images of Father and Son. Maybe the notion of the Holy Spirit is a little too vague or abstract for me? Maybe you too?

At the same time, though, we would irresponsible not to notice the ways the importance of the spirit in the life of faith and the life of the Church. From the earliest pages of the Old Testament, we see the Spirit at work up to the life of Christ and the early Church until today. I think we need to work harder, well I need to work harder, to pray for the presence of the Spirit.

I wonder if perhaps if we need to relax a little bit when it comes to that prayer. Now don't go saying that Fr. John is telling is to lessen our prayer time or not focus



as much. (Take a look in this bulletin for all the opportunities to grow in prayer in our parish.) I wonder if sometimes we do so much work to try and find the Spirit or see the signs of the Spirit. Can I suggest something a little different?

What if we slowed it down a bit? What if we relaxed a little bit? Maybe instead of looking so hard for the Spirit, what if we took some time to be present and open? Then, maybe it will be easier for the Spirit tofind us. What does Jesus tell us to do in today's Gospel? He tells us to not be afraid. He is sending us the Spirit. We do not have to find it.

I write this letter with the clear knowledge that this is an area of challenge for me. I find it that praying the Liturgy of the Hours, celebrating Mass, praying the Rosary, reading a spiritual book, etc. are things I can do. These are the things I can and must do. I am not as good at just sitting or just kneeling or just being in the presence of God without words or books or objects. Whether that be in Chapel before the Blessed Sacrament or sitting at the beach or sitting quietly in my room or walking without doing anything and so on.

At times, just being or sitting quietly or praying a simple mantra and so on can be a challenge. I can feel like I am not doing anything. (You may have picked up that I am a bit of a doer!) Yet, I know those times when I just am present and open it makes a great difference. The Spirit dwells there. Do you know how I know? I often can't recognize the difference. The people in my life do though. They'll say something like you seem at peace or you seem less on edge and the like. The Spirit works. It works better when I don't work so hard at finding the Spirit. It works better when I just leave room for the Spirit to find and dwell in me.






