A Message from our Pastor, Fr. Patrick...

Celebrating 125 years of St. John's

Whenever I hear today's Gospel, The Mission of the Twelve, I think of St. John the Baptist... in recalling the precursor's role in salvation history. How he was sent by God to lead the way to Christ and prepare the way of the Lord! To lead all of humanity to the one who has the words of everlasting life. In essence, John's role was to bring hope--new hope to a hopeless society and reassure the world of the greatness of God and His redemptive and

healing power! To point to the one who can restore us back to wholeness and bring us all new and everlasting life--the fullness of life with



Christ!

In today's Gospel, we see how Jesus extends His ministry to His closet disciples. We see how He summons the Twelve disciples to assist Him in preparing the way of the Lord. In proclaiming to all that the Reign of God is among us! To heal in His name and to lead all of Israel back to God, to a full encounter with Christ. To speak with authority and simplicity of heart and to do so with great humility and determination. To love endlessly and without counting the cost. To help gather the lost sheep of Israel, which represents the Church today and the complete love that God has for humanity.

We are being reminded during our 125th anniversary that we too, as a community of believers, are an extension of our Lord's ministry in our world today. That we have been empowered to help others come to believe in the one who guarantees us new and eternal life.

It is amazing how we, as a parish family, here at St. John's are connected to the first generation of believers, six generations ago. How we are part of the living history, here at St. John's, as we grow in our faith and love of Jesus each day. It is amazing how small this community was back in the late 1800's, like the size of a mustard seed, and how this parish has grown to the size it is today, to over 6000 families. How our parish family has grown in faith and size here in Center Moriches and the surrounding areas. To think that we are part of something very special in advancing the Kingdom of God and leading the way for others to encounter the healing power of the Lord, in word and sacrament, is a blessing indeed!

I would like to personally thank Bishop Barres, our Diocesan Bishop, for assigning me here almost one year ago and to my predecessor, Fr. John Sureau and my staff in making my transition here very peaceful and wonderful. To be close to my family, especially my parents, only makes it extra special for me. I am so blessed to be apart of your lives and the lives of your families. To serve here as pastor with all of you, my new parish family, is something I will always treasure for the rest of my priesthood. St. John's, for me, is a welcoming parish filled with love and gratitude!

I would also like to thank Bishop Coyle, our Eastern Vicar, for offering a Mass of Thanksgiving this weekend in celebrating 125 years of parish life and ministry here at St. John the Evangelist. Because of those who have served faithfully over the past six generations, in advancing the Kingdom of God, we have been strengthened and enriched in our faith, in keeping the Mission of the Lord and His Church alive here in the Moriches area.

Finally, let us pray for all of those who have asked for our prayers and those close to our hearts. Let us pray for those who have preceded us and for ourselves and for one another. Let us pray that we may continue to advance the Kingdom of God here in our local community knowing the enormous implications it can have on our society. Let us pray that we may be an extension of our Lord's ministry in leading future generations closer to Christ by being renewed and strengthened in our faith today. But even more importantly, let us pray that we may do the work of the Holy Spirit, which is the mission and the goal of our Universal Church with Jesus Christ as our Supreme Lord and Eternal Shepherd!

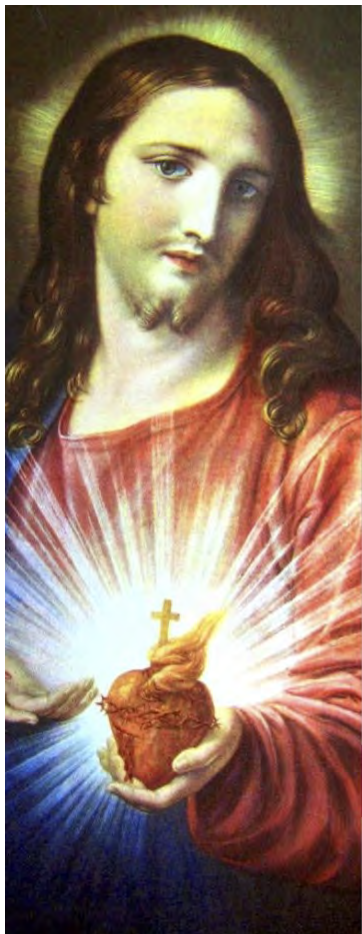
