From the Former Pastor's Desk

Always Gratitude SIGNS ON THE CROSS

Dear Parish Family:

I asked Fr. Patrick if I could write to you this week and I am grateful for the opportunity to reach out, in some way, to each of you.

I cannot thank you enough for your goodness and kindness to me throughout my six years at SJE and, most especially, over these past months. As you know, leaving St. John's is heartbreaking. Your prayers, encouragement, words of wisdom, and good spirit turned a leaving into a "sending forth" to St. Brigid's in Westbury. In a special way, I cannot thank you enough for an incredible Celebration of the Eucharist on June 26th and a true celebration of our parish that followed. I know there were certain people who "took the lead" but the party was a great sign of St. John's everyone coming together, even in the midst of a tough transition, to celebrate. What a celebration.

Thank you, too, for the many cards and notes and gifts offered to St. John's, OLQA, and Hope House on my behalf. Many of you know I try to write and respond to cards and notes and I hope to respond to each one in the months ahead. (Years ago—to date myself— "Dear Abby" said you have a year to respond to gifts and notes. I feel I will be pushing that deadline to the max!)

The people of St. Brigid's have been wonderful to me! Just as it is hard for me to take leave of SJE, it is not easy for the people here. As I wrote in May, Father Tony Stanganelli, the pastor I follow here, was a source of God's gentleness and kindness in so many ways. The people here love him and were blessed to be shepherded by him for the past nine years. I hope I can, in some way, follow in the path he has helped to provide here.

As you know, I started here on June 29th—the same day Father Patrick started at SJE. My first Mass at St. Brigid's was at 12:10 p.m. that day followed by a 5 p.m. Memorial Mass...so needless to say I hit the ground running! Needless to say, my heart was heavy. I put up a good front but it was a tough day with little time to process. As I prepared to walk out of the sanctuary I genuflected to leave and noticed something on the bottom of the cross here. It was the symbol of St. John the Evangelist. I made the picture bigger so you can see it. (I realize now that each of the evangelists is represented on the cross.)

I looked up to the ceiling and said "Alright, God, I know it'll be OK!" There have been many signs of consolation and encouragement in my week here, signs that the prayers and love of the community of SJE have prepared me well for this assignment and that you are never far from me, most especially when we celebrate the Eucharist. So know that each time I celebrate Mass, I am remembering the people of St. John the Evangelist...and God put a great sign there to remind me.



Please keep praying for me, especially in these days of transition. You are always in my prayers prayers of great gratitude to God for each of you!
