A Message from our Music Minister...

While sitting down to put some thoughts together regarding this column, one word kept appearing over, and over - gratitude.

Following the day of the fire here at SJE, I was approached by Father John in an eager and mostly calm voice saying "please take care of the instruments". What an opportunity and privilege it was to do so. Having only served the church in a larger manner for a few months, at first this all seemed very daunting. Not to mention the emotional impact of seeing my home parish blackened with soot and smoke damage. (As some of you may know, SJE is in fact my home parish, and I am also a graduate of OLQA).



Remember the brown 1913 Baldwin grand piano in the gym that sat there for 20 years? Well, after serving us well whilst worshipping in the auditorium, the first order of business was to send it out to be repaired, refreshed, and painted...an easy task as we had the support and guidance of Jimmy Osborne and his associates. New key tops, entirely new action, case paint, and bright work were all restored, or replaced. It continues to serve us well where appropriate in the liturgies depending on the demands of the music programmed.

Then there was the organ - the heartbeat of this incredible building. The fire pretty much finished off what time had done to our 1999 Rogers 960D three manual electronic organ - the amplifiers were failing, as were the tone generation circuit boards.

Sadly, parts were no longer available, and repairs by a third-party facility would far exceed its worth. It was deemed a total loss by the insurance company.

It was determined rather quickly that we were to begin an organ project; how exciting, I thought, for sure. Allen organs of Macungie PA was awarded the contract to build our new organ under my supervision. Steven Frank of NY Allen Organ even provided personal transportation out to the factory to see the incredible craftsmanship of these fine instruments. From the colors of the manuals, draw-knob engravings, speaker placement, renovations to the west wall, I was privileged to bring the music and sound of this church into the future.

Our magnificent Allen G460 is one of a kind, boasting 90 stops, four manuals, and over 50 speakers throughout the church in new hardened chambers, and pure digital amplification with toroid transformers from a rack in the sacristy closet...it's very integral to the building.

So, gratitude. First, I'm grateful I was granted the opportunity to use my skills and knowledge of pipe organs to make sure SJE has the most convincing of experiences each and every day this building is used for worship. I am also overwhelmed by the support and full-bodied singing that takes place here each and every weekend, holy day, and on feasts. You must know that all this work, and all the colors of this organ would be nothing more than a pretty concert hall without the robust and not all-too-common congregational singing that happens here at SJE.

In today's Gospel, we hear that Jesus went down to the sea and sat in a boat to teach via parables. I like boats, and I like the sea. Like the seeds that grew because of the rich soil, the great foundation of this wonderful church building will stand for generations, rooted in powerful sung prayer! The music helps take us away from the ordinary routines of secular life. "Whoever has ears ought to hear".

So... thank all of you!!! The congregation, community members and friends that support me and the music ministers here at SJE. You are the praying choir of the community. SJE is the cornerstone of the East End of Center Moriches. It makes it a place that is so very special and full of joy!

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

At Mass with my family recently, my five-year-old daughter caught the last four words of the mystery of faith as if she was hearing them for the first time. She was bursting with excitement as we finished saying, "We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection, until you come again." She turned to me and said, "Mom! We said, 'until you come again.' Does that mean Jesus is coming back? He's coming HERE?" What a lovely, emotion-filled response to learning that truth. She has heard those words countless times, but this time she heard the truth behind them. Her soul has been made for relationship with God from her time in the womb. The Holy Spirit has been preparing her to receive those words when she was ready to hear them in their fullness, and as the responsorial psalm proclaimed: "The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest." For those in the young, challenging years when it may seem easier to leave the little ones at home rather than take them to Mass, let's remember what we are told in the first reading from Isaiah. "Thus says the Lord: ... my word shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it."

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

How often do you find yourself listening to a friend or family member not to really hear what they are saying, but to plan your response? Do we do that while we pray as well? Sometimes I catch myself praying with an inner monologue behind it, deciding how I want that prayer to be answered. Now all of this may not be exactly what Jesus meant when he said, "This is why I speak to them in parables, because *they look but do not see and hear but do not listen or understand,*" but it is worth exploring. When we are so anxious to get our words in - either to another person, or to God, we're not really being the rich soil that the other's words deserve. We're not even the rocky ground or the thorny path of which the Lord speaks; we're more like a giant rubber wall off of which the words bounce! Let's take some time to consider how our practice of listening and receiving others, including the Lord, is preparing us (or not) for the return of Jesus. And if there is room to improve, now is a good time to do it.

PRAY *Lord, Jesus Christ, prepare my heart and my soul so that your words and your desires for my life will not fall on rocky soil. Give me the strength to be a Godly sower to all I encounter, especially my family, so your glory will be revealed. Amen.*
