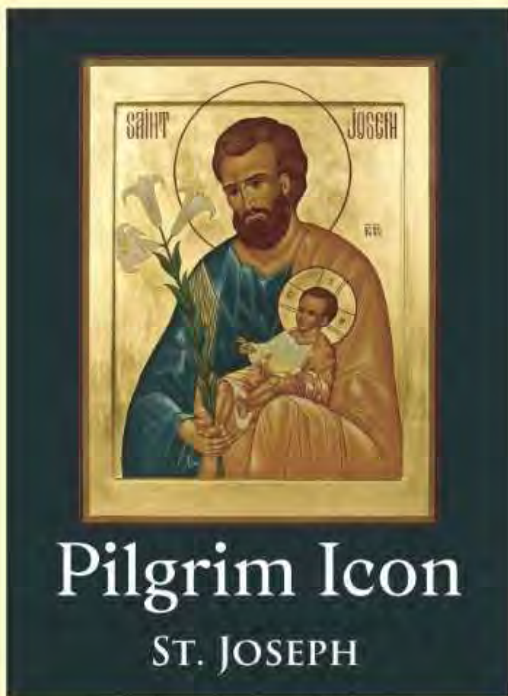

### Street Ministry: **Serving the homeless in our area each week**

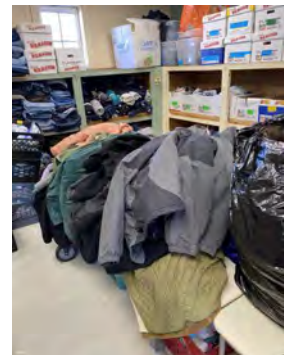

There will be a need for winter coats and blankets again in September; we have limited space so please hang on to them for us until then if you would. Thank you.

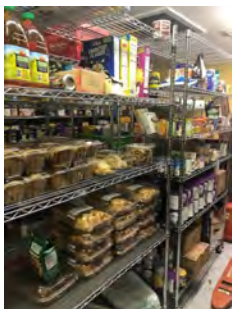
