FROM THE SEMINARIAN'S DESK

My Dear Parishioners

This past week I was not in the parish. I was at Quo Vadis camp in Huntington. It is over!

It was very busy and blessed time. Over 100 children, who want to STOP in their life who want to STOP from XXI century (games, cell phone, internet), chaos of life, noises, and bow down in Jesus in His arms. The most beautiful moment during the day was Eucharist and Holy Hour. During Holy Hour I saw how “young hearts” need God’s presence, how they want God in their life, how they cry, and their hearts and souls are moving by God’s Love. During this time, they celebrate the Sacrament of Penance and I saw how it was important for them. It is something beautiful when we can see that the young generation want to be witnesses of Jesus in this world. Quo Vadis camp is vocation camp. The priests and bishops talk to young people and show them how beautiful the life of a priest or religious sisters is. We also show them how a Catholic family should look like and what values a Catholic family has.

Camp is not only prayers and talks, it is also “fun”. We spend time hiking, preparing a fire place and eating marshmallows, playing games (that’s me throwing the water), painting, and playing volleyball, soccer, frisbee. During this time, relationships are established and this is a beginning of new catholic people for the future. It was a very blessed time, my last time as a seminarian. I’m looking forward to celebrating Mass for them next Quo vadis camp 2020.

Before I left for camp, I learned some very important news. Bishop Barres wants to have me ordained as deacon this year! It will take place on November 9, 2019 at St. Joseph’s Seminary in Dunwoodie. I also learned that I can go to Poland to visit my Mom and friends after my assignment here is finished.


Each week, I keep learning more and more about our parish. I admire the people who work in our thrift shop. It is so hot and humid. For them it does not matter what kind of weather. They do a very good job for other people. Thank them for this good example of charity and love and work!

I also attend Mass in the Yaphank prison. There are always three masses for women, for men and the Spanish Mass. During Masses I saw that the prisoners (who I love) very much need Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, and they really understand that Jesus Christ is in the Holy Eucharist. What was for me an amazing experience was that everyone, after receiving the Body of Christ, knelt down to pray. After the Gospel, Rev. John Gilmartin, Deacon Roger Mott, and I said a little reflection about the Word, a very nice experience. Deacon Roger Mott welcomes me and shows me what and how to do in prison. He shows me how to speak with prisoners and of course helps me with language.

I am also still involved with the Street Ministry. I had the chance to speak with the people who need help. Many times they really need to talk with somebody. It is a great job of our parish. Thank God many of you help us by prayers, donation food, clothes, money, and of course hands to help us. I am an unworthy servant making sandwiches with jelly and peanut butter.

Time is going very fast. I just came to our Parish and for a few days I’ll go back to my home Parish and after visiting Poland I’ll go to St. Mary’s in Roslyn.

I will see you soon.






