Street Ministry: Serving the homeless in our area each week

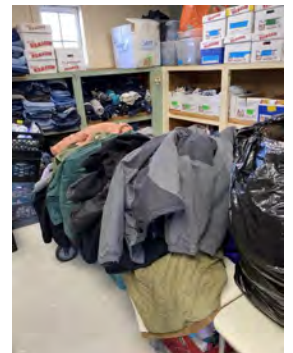

Ernie's Place Food Pantry:

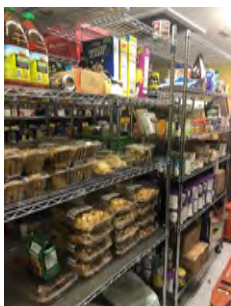
Serving those in need on Monday from 6:30-7:30 p.m. and Thursday from 3-4 p.m.
