A LETTER FROM FR. MICHAEL



I can't believe it's been just about a month at the time that I'm writing this since I first arrived here at St. John's in Center Moriches. It's amazing all that has happened in that month and how many times since being ordained a priest I've had to say, "It's all new to me". These first few weeks of priestly ministry have been the most beautiful and overwhelming time of my life.

As I said during my first weekend in the parish, the fact that a newly ordained priest has been sent to St. John's says more about this parish and it's pastor than anything else. When a man is ordained a priest, his first assignment and his first

few years of ministry are critical. The fact that I have been sent here says that the bishop and those who advise him see both St. John's and Fr. John as trustworthy enough to form a new "baby" priest. I can't believe how fast this first month has gone and how everyone has welcomed me so warmly since my arrival that I already feel to be a part of this parish family.

One of my heroes, Pope Saint John Paul II, had as his motto, "Totus Tuus", Latin for "Totally Yours". This is a reference to a prayer by another saint, Louis de Montfort, composed for consecrating oneself to the Blessed Mother. I myself have made this consecration and I have taken it for my own. Please God, I hope to lead many people in this parish to entrust their lives to Our Blessed Mother Mary too! I do believe in my heart of hearts that Her Son led me to this life as a priest and, in turn, led me here, to St. John the Evangelist. As an extension of this prayer, Totus Tuus, I say to all of you here in this parish, "I am totally yours". I desire to be your priest, your confessor, and your fellow pilgrim on our way to the Father's House.

General Instruction of the Roman Missal 162

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion assist the priest and deacon at Mass. At St. John's Extraordinary Ministers serve at Sunday liturgies and, when possible, daily liturgy. For Sunday liturgies, ministers are scheduled according to their availability and the needs of the parish.

How Do I Become an Extraordinary Minister?

- 1. You must send a letter to Fr. John at the Parish Office or e-mail to jsureau@sjecm.org
- 2. You must meet with Fr. John for a brief meeting.
- 3. You must attend one of the diocesan training sessions. If you wish to also bring Holy Communion to the sick and homebound, you must attend a separate "Part B" training session.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION - Confessions

At St. John's we celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation every day. During the week, we celebrate the sacrament after the 7 a.m. and 12 Noon Masses. Generally, the priests will be in the "living room" or the Chapel area of the Convent. He will wait or be around for 10 minutes after the last person has come. If Daily Mass is held in the Auditorium, the priest will be seated some place in the Auditorium after Mass.

On Saturday and Sunday evenings, confession are heard in the Youth Ministry Office (near the Main Entrance of the Auditorium) or in the back of the Auditorium itself.

With all of our movements in these weeks, we don't want to lose our commitment to and celebration of the sacrament of Reconciliation. (Of course, you can - and should approach one of our parish priests whenever you want to celebrate the sacrament.)
