





Michelle Pirraglia, Director of Faith Formation: A life-long parishioner, Michelle is entering her seventh year as DRE at SJE. With a passion for catechesis, Michelle oversees our parish's Faith Formation program of nearly 1,000 students and, in collaboration with staff and volunteers, helps develop and present our sessions.

Mike Walsh, Staff: A volunteer in several parish ministries with his wife, Lynn, Mike brings his years of experience in the education field as he helps coordinate and present our sessions to our family on campus.

Ann Caceres, **Staff**: A long-time catechist with three children in our program, Ann assists our parish families in many ways, particularly by using her bilingual skills to work with our Spanish Community.

OUR FAITH FORMATION MODELS:

Our program begins in First Grade, when students enter our two-year Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Through our "Family of Faith" program for students in Grades 1-6, parents and students come together on campus for our monthly sessions and then complete two or three activities during the month at home to grow in their faith as a family.

Our Confirmation preparation program typically begins when students enter Grade 7, with Confirmation taking place in the Fall of 9th grade. Using a youth ministry model, students meet twice a month to engage in the faith through guest speakers, small group discussion, media presentations and relatable, experiential learning.

Please put your donations in a bag labeled "Street Ministry" and drop in the green bins or leave in the Fellowship Area of the Church.


We ask that you be mindful of the season, we are currently accepting summer season wear.
