St. Januarius Ministry



You may have noticed a small change in our bulletin this week, our Blood Drive Ministry has changed its name to the St. Januarius Ministry, in recognition of the patron saint of blood banks.

Saint Januarius, a 3rd century martyred Bishop of Naples, is famous for the miracle of the annual liquefaction of his blood, which, according to legend, was saved by a woman called Eusebia just after the saint's death in 305. The blood is the subject of a longstanding miracle that claims, despite its age, to liquefy on three dates in the year, September 19, December 16, and the Saturday before the first Sunday in May. The bones and blood of St. Januarius, San Gennaro in Italian, are preserved as relics in Naples Cathedral in Italy.

St. John's has a long history of supporting the NY Blood Center. Please mark your calendar for Saturday, October 15th and consider donating blood, truly donating the gift of life. It doesn't get much better than that!

Grant, we pray, O Lord, that, having been replenished by such great gifts, we may gain the prize of salvation and never cease to praise you. Through Christ our Lord.

Readings for Next Sunday– 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Please look over these readings and consider these reflection questions before coming to Mass next Sunday.

First Reading + Deuteronomy 30:10-14

It suggests the concept of the law no longer written on tablets of stone but engraved on the heart, thus presaging the development of the wisdom tradition after the Exile. How did Paul apply this passage to the gospel?

Second Reading + Colossians 1:15-20

The divine wisdom becomes incarnate in Jesus, and the incarnation reaches its climax in the cross, the source of reconciliation and peace. It was a bold step for the New Testament to identify Christ with the preexistent "Wisdom." What led it to take this step?

<u>Gospel</u> + <u>Luke 10:25-37</u>

In Luke's dramatic construction, Jesus' acceptance of the lawyer's reply leads to a further question on his part. He wanted to "justify himself," to get the whole thing straight. He asks, "And who is my neighbor?"

More transitions...FATHER JAIME

I want to let you know about a change to Fr. Jaime's assignment. On June 29, 2022, Fr. Jaime will become the Parochial Vicar of St. Jude's in Mastic Beach while continuing to serve only the Spanish community here at St. John the Evangelist. He will no longer live at St. John's as his primary assignment will be to minister at St. Jude's. In a sense, it is a "flip" of his present assignment. Fr. Jaime has been serving here as the full-time Parochial Vicar of St. John the Evangelist while ministering to the Spanish community at St. Jude's in addition to this assignment. For the day to day life of St. John's, this will not be a significant change as Fr. Jaime will be here most Saturday evenings and Tuesday evenings for the Spanish masses. He will arrange with Father Patrick other details related to office hours, other assistance, etc.



In April, Fr. Jaime had asked to be on retreat and vacation from this past Monday through July 1st. He had these arrangements made prior to any changes in his assignment were officially known. While he may return early from vacation to handle the practical details of moving, he will not be on the schedule again until the Spanish Mass on July 1st.
