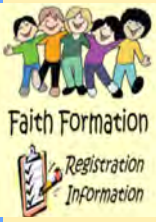

Baptism Help Needed

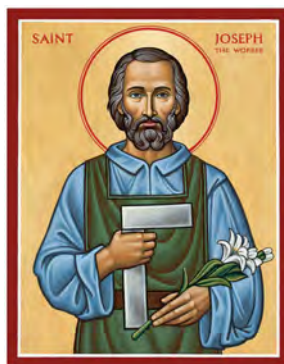

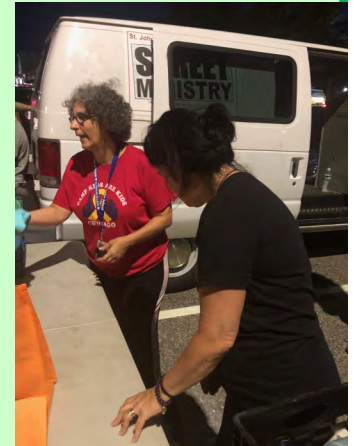
