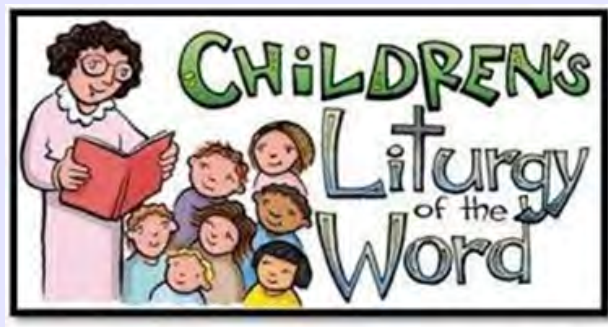

OUR FAITH FORMATION MODELS:

Our program begins in First Grade, when students enter our two-year Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Through our "Family of Faith" program for students in Grades 1-6, parents and students come together on campus for our monthly sessions and then complete two or three activities during the month at home to grow in their faith as a family.

Our Confirmation preparation program typically begins when students enter Grade 7, with Confirmation taking place in the Fall of 9th grade. Using a youth ministry model, students meet twice a month to engage in the faith through guest speakers, small group discussion, media presentations and relatable, experiential learning.

Bereavement Group.....

Grieving is a natural process each of us goes through after the death of a loved one. While no one can take away the sadness, others can help by listening and caring. Sharing feelings with others who have experienced the death of a loved one helps many people to heal.

St. John's Bereavement Group will begin meeting on Wednesday, October 5, 2022.

Facilitated by Loretta Gallagher and Maureen Harney, our group will meet weekly on Wednesdays, for 8-10 weeks from 10am to 11:30 in the Convent. Our beloved Sister Ann started this group about 10 years ago and it has been a great support to many in our parish community who have suffered the death of a loved one. If you, or someone you know might benefit from this support community we hope that you will join us. Many of our current and former participants have shared that the second year can often be more difficult than the first, sometimes managing through the first few months with support from family and friends but realizing that others sharing the same feelings are often the best supporters. Most people also find that a group is most beneficial if started not sooner than three months after the death, however this is an individual decision, and all are welcome at any time. We do ask for a \$10 donation for the cost of the program materials. If an evening group works better with your schedule, please reach out, we are open to facilitating an additional program if there is interest.

Readings for Next Sunday—

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Please look over these readings and consider these reflection questions **before coming to Mass next Sunday.***

First Reading + Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29

The word used by the ancient Romans, "humus," had a lot of meanings, among which were ground, earth and soil. Using this meaning as a springboard, make up your own definition of the word humility.

Second Reading + Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a

What is a covenant? What does it mean to say that Jesus is the mediator of a new covenant? Why does the sprinkled blood of the new covenant speak more eloquently than that of Abel, as this reading asserts?

Gospel + Luke 14:1, 7-14

Does anything cripple you, or sometimes make you blind? Discuss the fact that Jesus experienced our human pain along with us in order to help us get to the banquet. Do you feel any responsibility as a member of the body of Christ to help other people get to the banquet?

Street Ministry: Serving the homeless in our area each week

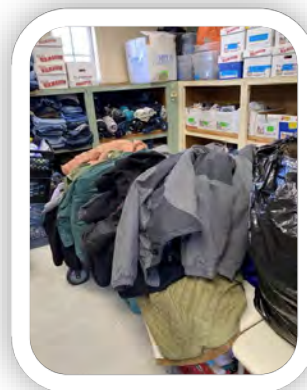
