I was working as an associate pastor at the Parish of St. Mary's in East Islip, on Long Island, N.Y.

Besides my pastoral work at the parish, I spiritually assist and celebrate the Mass for the Spanish inmates at the Yaphank Correctional Facility. I work also to celebrate the sacraments for a Spanish Community located at the Catholic Parish of St. Jude in Mastic Beach, N. Y. My priesthood formation was mostly in Colombia, in the diocesan seminary of the Immaculate Conception, from my native city of Manizales.

Later, I came to the U.S. and was ordained to the priesthood. Two years ago, I began to study the MCAT Online with the Catholic University in Washington D.C. This Fall, I will take my ninth course in the program, and begin my internship and graduation project. Hopefully, with your support and Fr. John's, I will be getting my degree in "New Evangelization and Catechesis" next year in the Fall.

What are my likes? Well, I am a movie fan. In fact, I have a collection of more than 100 movies. And to watch "The Oscars" is always a kind of spiritual obligation. I like sports like Soccer and Basketball. I am a strong noisy fan of the FIFA Soccer World Cup, enjoying every game and every goal, no matter the team or the hour (night or day time), GOOOOOOAAAALLLLL is something to celebrate.


