



Saint John the Evangelist has been a parish for 125 years!

The roots of our parish go back to the mid-1870's according to the records of the Dioceses of Brooklyn, which at the time included Long Island. The first Mass was celebrated on August 1, 1897. Since that time our Parish has experienced tremendous grown both spiritually and socially and whose faith has served to grow our parish community for

the past 125 years. Together we have made St. John's a strong and loving place to worship as well as a beacon of light and resilience in the Center Moriches community.

Father John started the 125th Anniversary Committee a month or two before he transitioned to St. Brigid's and our committee has been hard at work planning a variety of events to celebrate this milestone during the next year. There was once a single parish that extended from the hamlet of Brookhaven east to Westhampton, and from the Long Island Sound south to the Atlantic Ocean?

OUR FAITH FORMATION MODELS:

Our program begins in First Grade, when students enter our two-year Sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion.

Through our "Family of Faith" program for students in Grades 1-6, parents and students come together on campus for our monthly sessions and then complete two or three activities during the month at home to grow in their faith as a family.

Our Confirmation preparation program typically begins when students enter Grade 7, with Confirmation taking place in the Fall of 9th grade. Using a youth ministry model, students meet twice a month to engage in the faith through guest speakers, small group discussion, media presentations and relatable, experiential learning.







