

Dear Fellow Parishioners; Before we proceed with the YEARS details of the beginning of our St. John's Parish and location here in Center Moriches, it might be interesting and good to know of the financial support provided way back then by some very faithful benefactors without whom getting a physical reality established would have been next to impossible. Already mentioned in the last bulletin was the support of Mr. John Chapman donating the land upon which the original St. Mary's Church was built. Unfortunately, we have not been able to determine any further personal information regarding the generous Mr. Chapman.

Did you know...

The actual construction of that Church was funded by a donation of \$10,000 by John Masury of Brooklyn and Center Moriches — an amount which in today's dollars would amount to more than \$325,000. Mr. Masury, the owner of the Masury Paint Co. of Brooklyn, had become very wealthy by the invention of the standard (still standard today) paint can with the sealing cover, as well as other patents in the paint industry. John Masury, a protestant, and his wife Grace (formerly Harkins), Irish born and Catholic, aside from their Brooklyn residence occupied an estate in Center Moriches which was bound on the north by Montauk Highway, east by Senix Avenue, west by Old Neck Road, south by Moriches bay. This virtually self—supporting estate with its farming, fishing, and cattle raising employed at that time a significant number of Center Moriches residents. Throughout the next installments we will see how this particular family, as well as many other benefactors were of major contributors to the beginning and continuing operation of our St. John's Parish from its formal beginning in 1897.




This month we are combining our Sandwich making with the Sprucing up of our parish grounds as we prepare for our 125th Anniversary celebrations!!!

Grieving is a natural process each of us goes through after the death of a loved one. While no one can take away the sadness, others can help by listening and caring. Sharing feelings with others who have experienced the death of a loved one helps many people to heal.

St. John's Bereavement Group will begin meeting on Wednesday, October 5, 2022.

Facilitated by Loretta Gallagher and Maureen Harney, our group will meet weekly on Wednesdays, for 8-10 weeks from 10am to 11:30 in the Convent. Our beloved Sister Ann started this group about 10 years ago and it has been a great support to many in our parish community who have suffered the death of a loved one. If you, or someone you know might benefit from this support community we hope that you will join us. Many of our current and former participants have shared that the second year can often be more difficult than the first, sometimes managing through the first few months with support from family and friends but realizing that others sharing the same feelings are often the best supporters. Most people also find that a group is most beneficial if started not sooner than three months after the death, however this is an individual decision, and all are welcome at any time. We do ask for a \$10 donation for the cost of the program materials. If an evening group works better with your schedule, please reach out, we are open to facilitating an additional program if there is interest.




