



#### **Discussion Questions**

- 2. Paul goes from foremost sinner to foremost preacher. How does his conversion demonstrate God's forgiveness and mercy? Is God patient today with whole countries? With the Church? With you?
- 3. In the story of the prodigal son we hear that "While he was still a long way off, his father caught sight of him and was filled with compassion. He ran to his son, embraced him and kissed him." Was the father thinking about the son everyday and waiting for

him to come home? Was the son thinking "warm bed and food" or sorrow, having hurt his father? Does the father's forgiveness depend on the son's repentance? Why would Jesus tell us this parable?
